

2024 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

ELIGIBILTY

To be eligible for the BankStar Financial Scholarship, the following criteria must be met:

- Graduating High School Senior
- Attending an accredited post high school educational institution
- You or your immediate family must be either a primary or secondary owner on a deposit account, a primary owner or co-borrower on a loan account, or a primary owner of an insurance policy.
- Employees and members of the Board of Directors of BankStar Financial, and their immediate families (spouse, parents, siblings, and children, and each of their respective spouses regardless of where they live) and persons living in the households of these individuals, whether related or not, are **not** eligible.

Recipients will be notified by **April 19, 2024.** The \$1,000 scholarship award money will be payable to the recipient's account at their enrolled school of choice prior to the fall 2024 semester. BankStar will require applicant's proof of enrollment before sending check.

All eligibility requirements must be met to be considered for an award, and scholarships may not be used for any purpose other than tuition. If the requirements are not met, it may result in disqualification of the application. Award recipients agree to have their name and photo released to the media.

ACADEMIC (Up to 25 points awarded)

- Transcript (including your cumulative GPA & Class Rank) unofficial is fine
- ACT Score (if available)

ACTIVITIES/COMMUNTIY SERVICE (Up to 30 points awarded)

• Summary outlining your school activities, extracurricular, volunteer, religious, or special interest activities. Briefly describe your contribution and years involved. Also describe any employment experiences.

CHARACTER & GOALS (Up to 35 points awarded)

- In 200 words or less describe yourself including your goals and values. Describe attributes that may apply to you in the areas of integrity, honesty, trustworthiness, respect, and commitment.
- BankStar is especially interested in applicants who demonstrate a career interest in the financial services industry locally.

OVERALL PRESENTATION (Up to 10 points awarded)

Application will be reviewed based on professional presentation of all materials.
