The Harvey Buchholz Legacy Scholarship

The Harvey Buchholz Legacy nonprofit was formed in honor of the late Harvey Buchholz. Harvey was a pharmacist by profession and a giver to others through his many years of volunteerism. Harvey didn't let his physical impairments deter him from work, serving others, acting, golfing, playing pool, and umpiring softball. In 1960, Harvey was elected Mayor of Hendricks, MN and served in that position for 37 years. He helped establish the Hendricks Golf Course in 1964 and Deer Park. He was one of the first Kiwanis members in Hendricks and served in various officer positions for many years. Harvey was also on the board of Western Community Action (now named United Community Action Partnership) for over 40 years and helped to manage the movie theater when it was open. He was involved with the Lincoln County Relay for Life in various aspects for a number of years

The Harvey Buchholz Legacy encourages all to "Give like Harvey". The purpose of the Harvey Buchholz Legacy is 1) disburse a college scholarship to high school seniors in memory of the late Harvey Buchholz; 2) educate others on volunteerism and the importance of serving the community.

Scholarship Criteria

- Must be a high school senior graduating in 2024
- Must live or attend a high school in Minnesota
- Must be enrolling in a post-secondary institution (technical school, trade school, college, or university) in Fall 2024

One (1) \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded to a 2024 high school senior who resides or attends high school in Minnesota and one (1) \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded to a 2024 high school senior who resides or attends high school in Lincoln County, Minnesota.
